

PRACTICUM (APR 381)

- Students wishing to enroll in APR 381 Practicum must prepare a detailed proposal of what will be included in the course based upon prior discussion with a faculty member of their choice.
- The proposal must be submitted to the sponsoring faculty member before registering for APR 381.
- The proposal must be approved by the Department Chairman before registering for and taking the course.
- At least 10 hours per week must be devoted to the practicum project.
- Depending on the nature of the project, students may earn 1–3 hours of academic credit.
- The limit for credit for APR 385/386 and/or APR 381 is a total of 3 semester hours.
- Practicum requires junior standing, 2.5 or higher GPA and APR 322/332 or APR 422 (depending on the practicum).
- Students will receive a letter grade for this course.
